

# DEAR NEIGHBOR,



# THE YEAR IN REVIEW

Good Neighbor Health Clinic is a proud member of the Vermont Free & Referral Clinics, one of nine free clinics in the state of Vermont. Our organization actively collaborates with regional hospitals and health centers to support initiatives aimed at providing better care for our neighbors here in the Upper Valley. We are deeply grateful for the community support that allows us to deliver and expand the reach of these cost-free services to residents of New Hampshire and Vermont.

**51%** of our patients were from Vermont and **47%** of our patients were from New Hampshire

\$779,071+

#### YOU CARED FOR MORE NEIGHBORS IN NEED

Because of you, more people in the Upper Valley got the care they needed. Over the past year, we completed 2,230 appointments for 878 patients. One third of those individuals were coming to our clinic for the first time.

#### YOU CREATED MORE OPPORTUNITUNITES FOR HEALTH ACCESS

With your help, we hosted our first annual vaccination event protecting community members from seasonal illness, installed a point-of-care laboratory in the medical clinic, installed a harm-reduction vending machine behind our clinic, and strengthened partnerships with local organizations to better support our patients in meeting their needs.



With the support of our partners, neighbors were able to access nutritious food right after their appointments!



Clothes, personal care, and other helpful items remained available to neighbors through the community corner!



A total of 293 vaccinations were given last year!



Neighbors were able to receive blood pressure checks during community events!

Thanks to your continued support, the dental clinic was able to install 2 new x-ray heads. These upgrades allowed the dental clinic to see more new patients and eliminate the new patient waitlist.


